Grades 5 - 8

General Rules

1. Regular P. I. A. A. rules unless otherwise noted.
2. 4 - 10 Minute Quarters. Substitute any stoppage of play.
5 - 6 the Grade Division - Equal play STRONGLY ENCOURAGED but not required.
3. Clock will run continuous except for last 2 minutes of game ; then clock will stop in accordance with P. I. A. A. rules. Clock will also stop for shooting Fouls.
4. Time Outs - regular PIAA; i.e. 3 Full and 2 30 Second per Game.
5. Foul out; 5 - 6 Grade Division - 6 fouls; 7 - 8 th Grade Division - regular PIAA ; i.e. 5 fouls.
6. FULL COURT PRESSURE; 5 - 6 th Grade Division only the fourth period; 7 - 8 th Grade Division any time except for Gentleman & Ladies Rule below.
- 6a. **"Gentleman and Ladies Rule" - 5 - 6 th Grade Divison - 10 or more points; 7 - 8 th Grade Division - 20 or more points.**
7. Teams should report at least 15 minutes prior to game time. Games will start as scheduled ; as close to being on time as possible.
8. Each team will supply one (1) statistician per game to be seated at the scorer's table.
9. ***** Complaining to the referees by coaches, players, or parents will not be tolerated.**
In the spirit of good sportsmanship, any actions meant to demean opposing players, teams, spectators, and officials are NOT in the highest ideals of athletic education and WILL NOT be tolerated. Any person can be ejected from the building if it is deemed necessary. Let's all have fun as we hope to make this a prosperous endeavor for the good of our kids.
